Summer Teachers

Josie Burg- Ms. Josie's heavy background in modern, lyrical, and ballet, brings reflection and absorbed energy into her teaching and her choreography. She also trained in jazz and hip hop during her high school career. Over the course of her dance career Josie has trained and performed with the Allegro Dance Theater, DC Everest Dance Team, UW-Eau Claire Concert Dance Company and the UW-Stevens Point Dance Team. Josie has choreographed multiple college level pieces throughout her college career, including multiple pieces that were sent to ACDFA festivals. Josie has received various awards throughout her career including a choreographer award in the ACDFA Gala performance. Josie is also a professional photographer, graphic designer and a mom of two sweet children.

Daniela Flanders- Ms Daniela grew up in the Twin Cities and began dancing with the Classical Ballet Academy of Minnesota at the age of 9 and graduated in 2004. She went on to the UW-Madison, where she majored in Genetics and Zoology before beginning a career in dog behavior and animal welfare. In 2014, Daniela and her husband moved to Cheyenne, Wyoming where

she worked full-time as the Director of Operations of the Cheyenne Animal Shelter. During her time in Wyoming, Daniela returned to her ballet roots by taking adult ballet classes at a local ballet studio; soon after she began, she was asked by the studio owner to come on staff as a teacher for multiple levels of ballet. In 2017, Daniela returned to the Midwest, moving to Merrill, where she joined Wausau Academy of Dance and became a Board Advisor for Ballet Minnesota. Emily Giese- Ms Emily is a Wausau Academy of Dance alum and we are so excited to have her back as a teacher! While in high school she was also a member of the award winning DC-Everest Dance Team. She is a recent graduate of UW-La Crosse with a degree in Early Childhood Education. She has been teaching dance for the YMCA while attending college. Emma Graveen- We are excited to now call Ms. Emma our newest alumni on our teaching staff. Ms Emma has been a part of the competition team for many years and team captain for the last two. Guest Teacher, Taylor Huber-Ms Huber is a Minnesota native, who began dancing with Classical Ballet Academy (CBA) in 1996 and graduated in 2001. She has received several scholarships to numerous ballet summer intensives such as; Dance Aspen with Jillana, Virginia School of the Arts, Milwaukee Ballet School and Boston Ballet School. Taylor went on to the University of Kansas and the UW – Madison, under dance scholarships. She was a Ballet Minnesota company member from 2001-07 dancing several soloist roles such as; *Snow Queen* in *The Classic Nutcracker*, *Pas de Trois* in *Swan Lake*, *Flower Girl* in *Don Quixote*, *Willi* soloist in *Giselle*, *Dawn* in *Coppelia* and was in several of Andrew Rist's original works such as *Italian Symphony* and *The Black Dog Café*. Taylor has performed with several companies around the Twin Cities Metro and nationally performed the Grand Pas de Deux from *The Nutcracker* as a guest artist. After retirement she became a notable teacher and private coach with several schools all over the metro area. Notably with Larkin Dance for 8 seasons, including Eva Igo from World of Dance and Taylor Sieve from So You Think You Can Dance. She currently resides in Woodbury, MN with her husband and daughters, instructs ballet at both CBA Woodbury and Saint Paul locations and in her spare time teaches Barre Burn classes with Yoga Fresh in Woodbury. Taylor is incredibly proud to be a part of the Ballet Minnesota board, instructing the next generation of CBA, and to be a part of the Ballet Minnesota organization.

Guest Teacher, Eva Igo- Ms Igo is an award winning dancer and actress who trained at Larkin Dance Studio in Maplewood, MN. Ms Igo rose to fame at the age of 14 by placing second in the first season of *World of Dance*. She was featured in Jennifer Lopez's video, *Amor, Amor, Amor* and has acted in several films including *The Lost Astronaut*. She also appeared in an episode of *Dance Moms* where she received top score for her solo. We are so excited for this incredible opportunity to have Ms Igo teach and are thrilled for our students to be inspired by this talented young lady.

Taylor Javoroski- We are proud to say Ms Taylor is an alum of Wausau Academy. Ms Taylor is a talented performer and has inspired many young dancers to perform with heart. Guest Teacher, Ariel Juarez (AJ), AJ teaches Hip Hop for the UW-Madison Dance Department, is a native of Argentina and has been dancing for 16 years. He began his training in latin ballroom, but quickly discovered a love for lyrical jazz, musical theater, hip hop and modern contemporary styles. AJ studied dance at the Julio Bocca School of Musical Theatre and immediately began performing in productions of "Applause" and "Aladdin" in Argentina's Broadway. He was a member of Chet Walker's Fosse company, a featured dancer on Royal Caribbean Cruises and Celebrity Cruises, and has danced and choreographed for Argentina's "Dancing with the Stars," "Singing for a Dream," and "Dreaming to Dance." He also performed and choreographed for Carnival L.A and Millennium Experience also in L.A, As a teacher, AJ has worked at Millennium Dance Complex (both in Chicago and LA), one of the most recognized dance studio brands worldwide.
